For 2014, the HOA collected **\$4,630** in nonresident sport participation fees compared to **\$4,950** in 2013. For 2014, the HOA collected a total of **\$1,400** vending machine proceeds compared to **\$1,270** in 2013.

The 2015 budget and invoices were mailed the first week of December and the collections exceeded the December budgeted amounts.

The 2015 election information will be mailed to all owners on January 23rd by Vote-now. The results will be announced at the Annual Meeting on Tuesday, February 17, 2015. We have 900 email addresses to include, which is about 100 more than the 2014 election.

We have received approximately 10 applications for the Covenant Enforcement Assistant position and we will begin interviewing for this position within the next couple of weeks.

Amenity Monitoring: Advanced Protective Services is working part-time now. Please remember to bring your Legacy Park ID with you when you are on common property. The guards monitor all the amenity areas, including playgrounds, the lake, etc. The Kennesaw Police continue to work Friday, Saturday and Sunday evenings off duty, and they monitor Legacy Park's property. *Remember that neither the police nor the security company provides any security to privately owned property.*

Playgrounds: All necessary playground repairs were made in December and they are checked monthly by Recreation Station. If you ever see any problems, please report those to the HOA office.

Projects: We have made the down payment for the new covered pavilion on the Town Green and the plans have been ordered, we are waiting for the drawings to be presented to the HOA for approval. We are working on areas of the trails have been repaired due to damage from rain storms earlier this year. We are working on bids for a dehumidifier for the fitness center.

Landscape: New pine straw has been installed.

The election results will be announced at the Annual Meeting on *Tuesday, February 17, 2015*. By attending the meeting, your name will be entered in a drawing to have your 2015 assessments refunded.

There are two positions open on the Board. Each position is for a two-year term. You may vote for up to two candidates, including write-in candidates. Any Ballots which indicate votes for more than two candidates will be invalid for purposes of such election. Your vote is important and vital in the process. In order to establish quorum for a valid vote, ballots from members holding at least 10% of the total Association votes must be received. By casting your ballot, you are notifying the HOA that you are the designated owner representing your property's right to vote.

You must be the property owner on record; renters <u>CANNOT</u> vote. If the owner is a corporation, please include documentation as the authorized signer. Each property gets **ONE** vote, regardless of the number of owners. Please refer to the enclosed candidate information to help make your decision.

This letter serves as written notice to an owner who has a delinquent balance as of **February 13, 2015**, that you are in violation of Article X of the Covenants and your right to vote has been suspended. Should you disagree you may, within ten (10) days from the date of this notice, present a written objection to the Board regarding the suspension.

The voting period closes at <u>6:00 p.m. on Friday, February 13, 2015</u>. In order for your vote to be counted, your written Ballot must be received by Vote-Now by this time or your electronic vote must be cast by this time. The HOA office does <u>NOT</u> have access to this information.
