

# HOA News & Information

### PROPERTY MANAGEMENT REPORT

Is winter almost over? What a wet and dreary season we got to experience! It's not stopped us for gearing up for a busy spring and summer and progressing on some really exciting projects this year! After 3-years of not managing this community that I've lived in for 21 years, I am very excited to be back working with the leaders of our community and the awesome HOA staff. We have a lot in store for 2019! As we work on the Common Property, we hope you all enjoy sprucing up your home this year as well.

Yes, in January, we were busy preparing for the pool season. All new pool furniture is ordered, new fences at the Lullwater and Quiet pools are going in, landscaping has been cleaned up at the Lullwater and Main pool and the three pool houses are being painted.

Not only do we have our planned projects well underway, the rainy 2018 and winter months have caused some additional unplanned work in correcting drainage issues. The entrance to Madison is adjacent to a large wooded flood plain and the amount of debris in that area has clogged the drainage pipes, as it did along the powerlines in Madison. The powerline area has progressively gotten worse and we have done some extensive clean up and regrading to help the drainage. If your property is adjacent to the powerlines or any wooded area, please take time this spring to clean up your backyard and do NOT dump debris on any adjacent property or leave it in your own wooded area. This eventually causes drainage issues for someone to address. In these areas, debris has been a culprit in clogging drains and causing flooding along the streets. **The powerlines are private property and should NOT be accessed without HOA approval.** 

Along with the continuous rain comes wood rot. We are replacing the seat wall between the Main Pool House and Tennis Court 1 with a stone-block wall which should prove to be cost effective and low maintenance, unlike the current wood walls. Wood rot repair and painting are underway on our three Pool Houses, the Amphitheatre, Bandstand, Belltower, Tennis Pavilion and the Sign Boards. Interior work is being done at the Lullwater and Winterthur Pool Houses. We are also painting the guard rails on the Circle and Boulevard, along with the decorative light poles and sign posts. We have made a request to

Georgia Power to clean and paint the cobra head lights around the circle, we hope that gets done this year, as we look forward to the algae disappearing from all of our poles and brick work!

Cleaning up the circle also includes limbing up trees along the outside of the circle and adding irrigation, so the entire circle is covered. And late spring, look for new sod to be installed on the circle. Meanwhile we will continue cleaning up and sprucing up the trails and other amenity areas.

We will also be upgrading the lighting in the Clubhouse and Main Pool through an incentive with Georgia Power. Thank you to Steve Duby, Legacy Park resident in assisting us in the project to save energy and money!

We are looking forward to a great 2019! Please contact the office if you have any questions or suggestions!

### **FINANCIAL UPDATE**

In order to fund expenses for maintenance and upgrades of Legacy Park, annual assessments must be levied against each property. Our yearly budget is prepared based on the receipt of these assessments from all homewoners. If the assessments are not received, our financial position is impacted.

According to our records, as of February 13, 2019, the followling balances remain outstanding with the HOA. These are cumulative balances, not just 2019 outstanding assessments, i.e., includes owners who have had balances for years. This information is being provdided to keep our members informed of the financial status of the association.

### 2019 SPRING MAIL-OUT

It's hard to believe, but yes, spring is just around the corner and so is pool season. The pools are tentatively scheduled to open on Saturday, May 4th. As a rule of thumb, the pools open the first weekend in May each year. Remember that the Main Pool and Lullwater Pool have an electronic access gate, so make sure you get a new ID if needed! If in doubt, call, email or stop by the office so we can verify this for you.

During the month of March, the HOA office will send out 2019 amenity stickers to homeowners who have a **zero** balance on their account, i.e., no outstanding assessments, fees or fines. This mail-out will be sent via first class mail and will go directly to the owner on record. If you are a renter, you will need to contact the homeowner.



### LATE ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS

2019 Annual Assessments were due on January 1st and considered late after January 31st. If you haven't paid your assessments, you should have received a notice informing you that a 10% penalty was added to your account and your amenity privileges have been revoked. Please help us avoid additional time and expense – for you and the HOA – by making that payment now!

**REMEMBER** – if you owe money to the Legacy Park HOA, you and your family cannot participate in any of the activities that take place on Legacy Park property such as, playing tennis, participating in one of the many youth sports leagues, use the fitness center, use of any of the great amenities (playgrounds, pools, basketball court, baseball field, tennis courts, disc golf, amphitheater, bandstand, town green....) and rental of the clubhouse.

~ **Don't forget** ~ you can pay your assessments on-line through the Legacy Park website by credit card. Even though there is a \$20 processing fee charge to use the service, it is much less expensive than the attorney's fees and interest charges!

Don't forget to register for our new website! All sports registrations, payments, activities registrations, and minutes from board meetings require a sign in. If you have issues registering, please call the office.

### **SPRING CLEAN-UP**

Warm weather is almost upon us and lots of people are excited about their spring landscapes and flowers, along with sprucing up the exterior of their homes. We are, too! As just a heads up, here are a few things to think about while you are changing things. Please make sure none of your changes impact your neighbors property or common property. As always, if you are in doubt, contact us.

Many homes and driveways need pressure washing. Some homes may even need paint. Please remember not to paint your home, including a change of shutters or doors, without written approval from the ARC. When choosing colors, be sure to take the homes of your neighbors into account. No one wants to live on a street of all the same houses! If you need help choosing colors, stop by the office, we'd love to help.



**\*JUNK REMOV** 

Keep in mind that any alteration to the outside of your home requires written approval from the ARC, including changes to the backyard. If you plan to have trees removed, reach out to the City of Kennesaw, Public Works Department for a tree removal permit. If you need a recommendation for a professional, please contact the office.

### **Need New Landscaping?**

Now is the perfect time to plant new things for spring. The mild temperatures give the new plants time to establish before the hot summer arrives. If you plan to renovate your beds, please send in details on a modification form (found in the website Knowledge Base). Beds cannot be changed without written approval from the ARC,

unless you are only pruning existing shrubs/bushes or adding spring color. Keep in mind that changes should include plants native to this area. If you need suggestions, call us! Happy Planting!

Dogs MUST be on a leash when on Legacy Park common property. Please clean up after them, too.





### **Glass Recycling**

We have 3 new glass recycling containers in Legacy Park! Thanks to a school project with Harrison High School students, we have 3 locations where you can drop your glass food and drink containers to be recycled.

Please remember only food safe glass is accepted. Adding other types of glass will cause everything in the container to not be recycled.

Containers are emptied on a regular schedule by the students.

-Furniture removal and hauling

-Remodel debris loading & hauling -Garage, attic, basement clean ups

-Appliances, Mattresses, Scrap, etc

-Anything you consider Junk!



  Swim suit fitting and ordering: LP Clubhouse on Sunday, April 14th (1pm 3pm).


### **BASEBALL/TEE BALL**

### **GUEST POLICY**

When bringing your friends to the amenities, keep in mind the guest policy:

Up to four (4) guests will be allowed per resident over the age of 18 for use of the Trails, Town Green, Playgrounds, Amphitheater, Bandstand, and Baseball Field.

Up to two (2) guests will be allowed per resident **over the age of 18** for the use of the Swimming Pools, Tennis Courts, Volleyball Court and Basketball Court.

Unaccompanied children between the ages of 12 and 18 are allowed only one (1) guest while on LP property and when using the amenities.

Guests are considered to be non-LP residents. LP residents that have had their privileges revoked cannot come as a guest of another resident.

A LP resident must accompany guests while on the common properties or while using any of the amenities. Long term guests (persons visiting for more than two weeks) may obtain a guest pass from the HOA office. As a reminder, homeowners are responsible for ensuring that their guests are informed of the rules of LP and that these guests follow the rules at all times. The LP HOA reserves the right to suspend privileges or prosecute an individual, resident or guest, for destruction, abuse or misuse of property.
