HOA News & Information

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT REPORT

This has been a super busy spring for the HOA. On any given day, you can find a plethora of contractors working on our Common Property. All the amenities have had work done to them and look great! The landscaping around the circle is going to look fantastic this summer after all the projects are complete. It has been a group effort to get this work done, starting with the Board approving funds for projects and Lisa and Joanne ensuring all the work gets done. The two Danielles and Morgan pitched in by taking care of the office. And, all this couldn't have been done so smoothly without our handyman Mike Manley, he's been a true asset to the HOA. We have an HOA that is committed to getting things done and ensuring this community looks its best! We all love this community and hope you enjoy all that it has to offer!

Spring Mailout – The 2019 amenity package was mailed on April 8 to owners who are in good standing with the HOA. Each family received four stickers for their amenity IDs. Collections for 2019 are going according to budget, collection letters have been sent and liens and lawsuits will be filed in May for delinquent accounts pursuant to the HOA schedule.

Landscape – The landscape work has continued throughout Legacy Park. The mulch application around the Circle is completed. The winter flowers have been pulled and the spring flowers are installed.

The irrigation project along Legacy Park Circle is completed and new zoysia that will be installed in the beauty strip and along the circle where there is no grass during May.

We will begin working on repairing the trails this summer as some of the other major projects wind down.

Swimming Pools – All the pool houses have been repaired and painted and all pool decks and sidewalks have been pressure washed. We had the Mushroom painted a refreshing green color. The Winterthur bathrooms have been renovated with new fixtures and new paint. A new motor has been installed at the Main Pool as well as an unplanned repair to one of the 4 filters. New pool signs have been installed and look so great! Please read them when you arrive at the pool.

New landscape material has been planted next to the Lullwater Pool fence where we removed overgrown Lelands earlier this year. A new bicycle rack will be installed at the Lullwater Pool house.

A new HVAC has been installed at the Main Pool house replacing the original unit that no longer worked.

Painting & Spring Cleaning – Repairs and painting have been completed at the Sign Boards, Belltower, Bandstand, Amphitheater and Tennis Pavilion. All the sidewalks adjacent to the amenities and all the monuments have been pressured washed. The roofs at the Clubhouse, Main Pool House, pool pump houses and the Baseball dugouts have been cleaned.

We will begin working on getting the guardrails and light poles on the Circle painted. The street lights in the community are scheduled to be painted by Georgia Power this summer.

Tennis Courts – LED lights are installed on Court 1 and will be installed all on courts during May. Tennis court repairs & resurfacing were completed during spring break on courts 2, 3, 6 and 7. All tennis court fences have been repaired as well. The replacement of the seat wall next to Tennis Court 1 is finished and looks beautiful.

Basketball Court – The fence and gate have been repaired.

Clubhouse – Additional rocking chairs have been placed on the exterior and we are working on replacing interior furnishings.

Graduation – We received around 150 graduates' names for the May newsletter. We will be ordering signs to line the Boulevard, which begins around May 17th.

AMENITY MONITORING

Please remember to bring your Legacy Park ID with you when you are on common property. Our courtesy patrol monitors all the amenity areas, including playgrounds, the lake, etc. They will ask you for your ID. The Kennesaw Police continue to work Friday, Saturday and Sunday evenings off duty, and they monitor Legacy Park's property. Remember that neither the police nor our courtesy patrol provides any security to privately owned property.

Please remember that children under 12 MUST be accompanied by a ID carrying resident 16 and older. Unattended children will be asked to leave common property.

2018 POOL SEASON – POOLS OPEN MAY 4TH

Swimsuit season is here!

We want to ensure that our facilities are used by Legacy Park residents and their guests only, so be ready to show your Legacy Park ID with your 2019 sticker.

Opening: All the pools will open on Saturday, May 4th. The Main Pool and Winterthur Pool will be staffed with lifeguards on Saturdays and Sundays only until May 22nd.

The Lullwater Pool will be staffed each day, see the schedule below.

Please do not let your children under age 16 go to the pools without an adult when it is not guarded. We will be checking the pools periodically and anyone under age will be asked to leave and we will contact their parents. It's **ALL** about the safety of our children, please help us, it is your community.

THE QUIET POOL

Please remember that the quiet pool (the smaller pool below the main pool) is for QUIET activities. Please be courteous to your neighbors who come to this pool for some quiet time! Each pool season, we get inquiries about making this pool an "adult only" pool. The Federal Housing Act makes it illegal for any community association to discriminate against age; i.e., HOAs cannot prohibit someone from being at a pool unless the limitation is reasonably related to the health, safety or welfare of the person. Therefore, Legacy Park has rules in place for guarded and unguarded pool times as outlined above.

LEGACY PARK ID – DON'T LEAVE HOME WITHOUT IT!

All Legacy Park residents **over the age of 12** must carry their Legacy Park picture ID with them while on Legacy Park property. If you do not have your ID you will be asked to leave the Legacy Park common areas and amenities. If you have a zero account balance with the HOA, you should have received your 2019 stickers in the mail. If you haven't received your stickers, contact the HOA office.

If you don't have an electronic access card stop by the office and get your new card. If you have lost your ID you may obtain a replacement at the office. All replacement cards are \$10.00.

******If you have a card that gains you access to the gym and/or Quiet Pool, you are all set for this season, just put your 2019 sticker on it!******

When bringing your friends to the amenities, keep in mind the guest policy:

Up to four (4) guests will be allowed per resident **over the age of 18** for use of the Trails, Town Green, Playgrounds, Amphitheater, Bandstand, and Baseball Field.

Up to two (2) guests will be allowed per resident **over the age of 18** for the use of the Swimming Pools, Tennis Courts, Volleyball Court and Basketball Court.

Unaccompanied children between the ages of 12 and 18 are allowed only one (1) guest while on LP property and when using the amenities.

No one under 12 is allowed on LP property without an ID carrying resident over 16.

Guests are considered to be non-LP residents. LP residents that have had their privileges revoked cannot come as a guest of another resident.

An LP resident must accompany guests while on the common properties or while using any of the amenities. Long term guests (persons visiting for more than two weeks) may obtain a guest pass from the HOA office.

As a reminder, homeowners are responsible for ensuring that their guests are informed of the rules of LP and that these guests follow the rules at all times. The LP HOA reserves the right to suspend privileges or prosecute an individual, resident or guest, for destruction, abuse or misuse of property.

A Note from Covenants...

Everyone that lives in our neighborhood will at some point get a letter about your property. It could be something small, like needing flowers in empty pots, or something large, like needing to paint your house. The letter tells you that you have 10 days to Respond, Correct, or Dispute. No one expects large projects to be completed in 10 days, but a response within that time is required. After this initial response, we can guide you on the path to correct the violation. You can always ask for more time to correct or appeal the violation. Response is key! If there is no action in the 10 days, fines start accruing...and we prefer not to fine owners, but see a violation corrected. We would rather you use that money on your home! If in doubt, please reach out to us. We are always happy to help.

Where are your children? When you are at the swimming pool, walking in the park or your kids are playing outside, remember that, as parents, it is our responsibility to keep our children safe. Please be respectful of your neighbors and don't let your children play in their yard without the owners' permission. And please don't let your children leave items in the street, i.e. skate board ramps, and other play equipment. Our streets are not wide enough to have to dodge children playing in the streets and cul-de-sacs, but having to dodge their toys too is difficult and not safe.

For the tenth year, we are honoring Legacy Park residents who are graduating in this edition of the newsletter. The Legacy Park HOA will be continuing the tradition of lining Legacy Park Boulevard with signs for each senior. Play safe by supervising your children.

Remember that no one under the age of 12 should be on common property without proper adult supervision. It only takes a few seconds for kids to incur a life threatening injury or disappear.

Wildlife.....Legacy Park has a lot of wooded areas and creeks, which tend to attract various types of wildlife. We all see the deer population, but we don't always see are the snakes that live here as well. Please talk to your children about being aware of snakes, especially around the creeks that run through the community.

Are you in a hurry? Please don't take the chance of hurting someone! Cars are often parked along the side of Legacy Park Circle and Legacy Park has a lot of walkers that cross the street. Remember that "stop" signs are not optional; the Kennesaw Police will issue you a ticket if you decide to not come to a complete stop at the intersections. Slowing down and paying attention could save a life.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

This is a reminder of the Rules and Regulations that apply to motorized vehicles on Common Property: Motorized vehicles are not permitted on the walking trails or Town Green. This includes motorized scooters, motorbikes, mopeds, off road vehicle and electric/ gasoline hybrid vehicles, etc. (except for official Legacy Park vehicles). The HOA staff and/or Board of Directors may approve limited use under special circumstances.

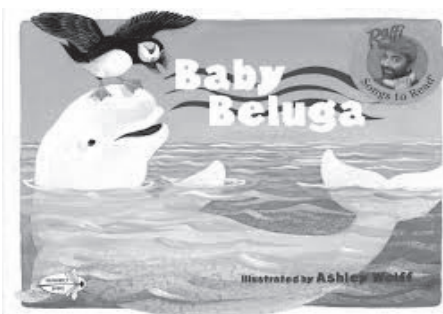

- Mow, trim and edge lawn areas

- Hydroseed lovegrass and warm season grasses
