HOA News & Information

2020 HOA BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION

Three of the five HOA Board of Directors seats are up for election in 2020. The voting results will be announced at the February 2020 Annual Meeting. Nominations must be submitted by Monday, November 4th, and biographies and headshots by Monday, November 11th to be included in the Town Herald. A list of candidates along with their biographies will be in the December Town Herald if submitted by the deadline.

We will be utilizing electronic voting again this year with Vote-Now, which is the same company we used for the past three years. Vote-Now manages the entire voting process. No one outside of that company has knowledge of any voting results. The results are sent to the HOA in a sealed envelope the day of the Annual Meeting. That sealed envelope is opened at the Annual Meeting in front of all attendees, i.e., we all find out at the same time which candidates are elected to the Board.

2020 ASSESSMENTS

The Board will be voting on the 2020 budget and setting the assessment amount at their Board meeting on November 26, 2019. Look for the information to be mailed out in early December.

REMINDER – Holiday Decorations

Legacy Park Rules and Regulations state:

- 1. Holiday displays must not create a nuisance for adjacent property owners. All holiday decorations including lighting displays must not attract increased traffic flow.
- 2. Holiday season displays may only be used from Thanksgiving through the weekend following New Year's Day. Decorations for other holidays may only be displayed up to two (2) weeks in advance of the occasion, or the month of the occasions whichever is longer, and must be removed no later than seven (7) days following the holiday.

LANDSCAPE ENHANCEMENTS

As you have seen our lovely fall flowers have been installed throughout the community. These flowers are often a tasty treat for our deer. To preserve our flowers, deer deterrents have been put in place to allow the flowers to thrive. The deterrents are not harmful to the deer. The Landscape Committee has been working on a design for the front entrance after it was damaged. We hope to have this project completed as soon as possible.

LANDSCAPING TIPS FOR NOVEMBER BY HUTCHESON HORTICULTURAL

- Mow, trim and edge lawn areas
- Continue <u>Leaf Removal</u>
- Begin shut down and winterization of irrigation systems
- Continue flower maintenance (Deadheading, fertilization and weeding as necessary)
- Apply post-emergent to control weeds as necessary
- Apply slow release fertilizer to fescue lawns
- Complete installation of fall color
- Install spring flowering bulbs
- Fall digging begins. Install balled and burlapped trees and shrubs
- Cut back perennials after 1st frost dieback






