

Please take the time and vote for the owners that you want to lead this wonderful community for the next two years.

Voting is underway, with the voting period from January 26, 2024, to 4:00 p.m. on February 9, 2024. Homeowners are provided with the convenience of voting electronically or by mail-in ballot. If you choose to mail a paper ballot, send it to Vote-Now at the address provided in your voting materials. Please do NOT send it to the HOA office.

The email address we have on file for you has been provided to Vote-Now unless you asked us not to share it with them. If we do not have electronic communication with you, the voting package was mailed via USPS. Vote-Now manages the entire voting process, no one outside of that company knows any voting results.

The voting results will be announced at the February 15, 2024 Annual Meeting, which will be streamed online. The results are sent to the HOA in a sealed envelope on the day of the Annual Membership Meeting. That sealed envelope is opened at the meeting in front of the camera and all attendees, i.e., we all find out at the same time which candidates are elected to the Board.

During election time, please remember that the HOA does not endorse any candidate(s). All official information about the election will be sent by the HOA or Vote-Now. Other information may be sent by individual candidates. The official forms of Legacy Park HOA communications are the Legacy Park Town Herald (newsletter); Legacy Park Website (www. legacypark.org; Buildium; and/or Legacy Park HOA email distribution list (maintained and controlled by the HOA Staff). GARDENING - A CAUTIONARY TALE

have now joined the many neighbors who have had critters in their attics! For those of you who are new to Legacy Park, I have learned that our lovely woods with large trees with acorns galore attract squirrels and rats.

Look up in the trees. Do you have squirrel nests? Are there tree branches offering easy access to your roof? Now that winter is here, those critters want to be warm. It is said that squirrels have three liters a year, and they are nesting right now for the first batch. The most common pests are squirrels, rats, mice, bats, birds, and raccoons.

It is better to realize you have visitors camping out in the attic sooner rather than later when they have damaged and soiled your insulation or have chewed on wiring.

WHAT TO DO?

Check the exterior of your home regularly to see if there are gaps where

they might enter. They can get in through very narrow openings.

- Minimize branches that offer them easy access.
- Roof vents need to have covers that keep them from being used that way to get in your attic.
- Check your attic insulation regularly to see if there is evidence of tunneling or nesting.

The prices for getting rid of these pests can vary dramatically. There are wildlife companies, insulation companies, and some are combined. I was astonished at the difference in pricing. I hope the one I picked, which does have stellar reviews, does a good job removing the damaged insulation and blowing in new. It will be deeper, which will help my utility bills.

Next month I will return to happier subjects: landscape planting choices!

Once we get rolling with the pinewood derby car races we are also going to be visiting the aquarium to spend a night with the fishes in February.


All of this is definitely a fun start to the year with more fun to come throughout the year.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT REPORT

eady for 2024? The beginning of the year is a busy time for the HOA office. Between collecting assessments, preparing for the Annual Membership Meeting and Board Election, and staying on top of the daily maintenance of the common area, we are also gearing up for the projects in 2024. And spring is just around the corner, and with that

comes the 2024 pool season!

In January, Swim Atlanta jumped on the swimming pool maintenance projects. The sand has been replaced in the Quiet Pool & Winterthur Pool filters. And a new pump has been installed in Winterthur. The brick border has been replaced around the main pool.

Gibson Landscape Services has kicked off 2024 by getting familiar with the property and handling maintenance issues during the winter season. They will be doing some hard pruning of our older landscape and cleaning up. We look forward to working with them on the 2024 landscape projects

Other projects that we are working on include the following:

- Signpost Replacement: We have contracted with GSI Mailboxes to replace the signposts in Annadale, Kentmere, Palisades, and Olmsted. In 2025, we will replace the signposts in Highcroft, Winterthur, and Revere. This will complete the replacement of all posts in the community.
- Amenities: We are gathering bids for painting the Main, Lullwater, and Winterthur Pool Houses, the Bandstand, the Amphitheater, the the Belltower.

STREET MAINTENANCE IN LEGACY PARK

DO YOU HAVE A DOG THAT LOVES TO WALK IN LEGACY PARK?

Did you know that it is not only a violation of Legacy Park's Rules & Regulations, but it is unlawful in the City of Kennesaw for the owner of any animal to permit such an animal to be out of his immediate control and restraint? All animals shall at a minimum be maintained on an appropriate chain, leash, or tie not exceeding six feet in length, and in the hands of a person who possesses the ability to restrain the animal.

A friendly reminder that pets are not permitted within any fenced area owned and maintained by LP (e.g., ballfield, tennis courts, pool area, playgrounds, etc.).

Remember, as a responsible pet owner, it is your responsibility to clean up after your pet..... pick up, and properly dispose of your pet's waste. Failure to adhere to this rule may result in the suspension of amenity privileges. Trash receptacles and doggy waste stations are located throughout LP to aid in the disposal of such waste.



COMMUNITY-WIDE STANDARDS

s a result of notices sent to Legacy Park owners, we get many follow-up questions. Do you have a question about a rule for the HOA? Let us know, we can share the question and answer with the other Legacy Park owners.

This month's subject is "community-wide standards" ...what is it and what does it mean, it is too vague, it is too subjective, it does not apply, etc.

As an Owner in the Legacy Park Community, you are legally bound by the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions for Legacy Park (CCRs), the Bylaws rules, and regulations (collectively, "Governing Documents"). The following two sections of the CCRs address communitywide standards.

CCR 5.2 Owner's Responsibility:

Each Owner shall maintain his or her Unit and all structures, parking areas, and other improvements comprising the Unit in a manner consistent with the Community-Wide Standard and all applicable covenants.

CCR 5.4 Standard of Performance:

Responsibility for maintenance shall include responsibility for repair and replacement, as necessary. All maintenance shall be performed in a manner consistent with the Community-Wide Standard and all applicable covenants.

Legacy Park Design Standards and Rules and Regulations are intended to ensure the protection of the Legacy Park concept, the "traditional" character of the community, and individual property values through the establishment of architectural standards.

Architectural guidelines:

The regulations about the design, color, materials, and structure of buildings or renovations within the community to ensure consistency and aesthetic appeal. Keep in mind that the architectural style of your home does not change from its original design.

CCR Exhibit C.3 Prohibited Conditions:

Structures, equipment, or other items on the exterior portions of a Unit that have become rusty, dilapidated, or otherwise fallen into disrepair.

This includes items such as the paint on your house that has faded; wood rot that needs to be replaced; the severely cracked driveway that needs to be replaced; the fence that is falling, your mailbox post that isn't a standard height because of the rusting; your roof that is missing shingles; a missing shutter; and so much more!

Landscaping and outdoor maintenance:

The rules regarding lawn care, tree maintenance, gardening, and general upkeep to maintain a uniform appearance throughout the neighborhood. Standards include keeping your grass mowed and free of debris; not leaving grass clippings in your yard; pulling weeds from your landscape beds; removing dead trees; replacing dead plants; trimming your bushes regularly; not having empty landscape beds, etc.



WILDLIFE IN LEGACY PARK

egacy Park is a beautiful community with hundreds of acres of wooded land, a pond, a major creek, and power lines. These are all ideal features for an excellent habitat for wildlife, including deer and coyotes. The following information is provided to inform residents and their guests that coyotes do live amongst us.

The Department of Natural Resources and the Atlanta Coyote Project have great information about coyotes and their coexistence with humans. While they are typically not a threat to humans, it is important that residents do not encourage interaction with the animals and that steps are taken not to provide coyotes with food sources. For this reason, coyote eradication programs are discouraged unless an animal is observed to be aggressive. Eradication does not have a lasting effect, as other coyotes will soon move into the area seeking the same food, water, and shelter that attracted any who may be removed.

The Association is not an insurer of safety and is not obligated to trap the animals. We are here to provide you with information and encourage you to research to ensure you and your guests are educated about wildlife and use reasonable caution in the community.

Coyotes are animals of opportunity, so they will forage through garbage, eat pet food left outside, and will attack small pets that are left unattended, even within fenced yards. Coyotes are intelligent and can easily find ways to get inside fenced areas if they see potential food or other reasons to get inside.

WHAT TO DO/RECOMMENDATIONS: PREVENTIVE MEASURES AND PASSIVE MANAGEMENT ARE THE BEST WAYS TO AVOID COYOTE CONFLICT.

- Never feed coyotes and always prevent their access to food around your home.
- Do not leave pet food outside.
- Make trash cans inaccessible and secure them with tight lids.
- Control small mammals from feeding in and around bird feeders, which can attract coyotes.
- Clean and store grills when not in use.
- Properly dispose of dead animals, including any nearby roadkill.
- Do not allow pets to roam freely and take them indoors at night.
- If pets must be kept outside, consider installing fencing and motion-activated lights to discourage predators.
- Keep small livestock and poultry in enclosed or sheltered areas.
- If you see coyotes near your home and feel uneasy about their presence, make loud noises, spray them with a hose, and generally make them feel unwelcome.

Coyotes & Wildlife Are **Active In This Area**

SHOULD YOU COME IN CONTACT WITH A COYOTE:

- Do NOT approach the coyote.
- Do NOT run from the coyote.
- · Face the coyote, waive your arms slowly and speak in a loud voice.
- · Back away slowly to give the coyote an opportunity to escape.
- Maintain eye contact with the coyote at all times.

PROTECT YOUR PETS

- Keep pets on a short leash within your sight.
- Do NOT allow dogs to interact with coyotes.






Why KILLING Doesn't Work

Shoot or poison coyotes and you will have just as many again within a year or two. Kill one or both members of the alpha pair (A)—the only one that normally reproduces—and other pairs will form and reproduce. At the same time, lone coyotes will move in to mate, young coyotes will start having offspring sooner, and litter sizes will grow.






Only the alpha pair reproduces, and its litturs are small. Pack members are less likely to eat sheep.



Cuts numbers by half, but only temporarily.



PACK DISRUPTED BY LETHAL CONTROL Survivors, joined by males from outside, start reproducing. Litter sizes increase. The need to feed many pups can lead adults to prey on sheep.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where is the HOA administrative office?

It is located at ground level of the Legacy Park Clubhouse.

When does the Board of Directors meet?

On the 4th Tuesday of each month in the evening at the Clubhouse. All homeowners are welcome to attend.

How do I obtain an amenity ID card and current stickers?

Amenity tag stickers are distributed, by mail, in the spring of each year, if dues are paid in full. The ID card with a current sticker allows homeowners access to all of Legacy Park's common area and amenities. To get the ID card, please complete the form on our website under the Resident tab prior to stopping by the HOA office.

How many guests can I have?

Up to (4) guests are allowed per resident over the age of 18 for use of the Trails, Town Green, Playgrounds, Amphitheater, Bandstand and Baseball

Up to (2) guests will be allowed per resident over the age of 18 for the use of the Swimming Pools, Tennis Courts, Volleyball Court and Basketball Court.

Unaccompanied children between the ages of 12 and 18 are allowed only one (1) guest while on LP property and when using the amenities.

Unaccompanied children between 12 and 15 cannot have a guest younger than themself.

Guests are considered to be non-LP residents. LP residents that have had their privileges revoked cannot come as a guest of another resident.

A LP resident must accompany guests while on the common properties or while using any of the amenities. Long term guest (persons visiting for more than two weeks) may obtain a guest pass from the HOA office.

It is required that a modification application be approved by the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) before any changes are made to the exterior of your home, i.e. landscaping, painting, etc. Refer to Design Standards for additional information and restrictions. All violations of the Covenants or Design Standards may be assessed penalties.

What modifications do I need to get Q approval for?

Approval is needed for anything you do on the exterior of your home and property, front and back. This includes all landscaping, paint (even if painting the same color), new door, new roof, new windows, fence, patio, trampoline, etc. If you are not sure if it needs approval, please contact the HOA office.

When are Homeowner Assessments Q

They are due annually by January 1st. An invoice will be sent prior to this date; however, as stated in our covenants, not receiving an invoice is not a valid reason for not paying your assessments. Refer to Declaration of Covenants-Article X. A 10% late fee will apply for payment received after January 31st and interest will accrue on the assessment with a late charge at an annual rate of 7%.

What happens if I don't pay my Q **Homeowners Assessments?**

As mentioned above, there will be a 10% late fee and interest will accrue on the assessment with a late charge at an annual rate of 7%. Also, suspension of all Owners' rights to access or use any of the Legacy Park common areas, amenities and any Legacy Park supported events will occur. The HOA also reserves the right to take legal action, including but not limited to, liens against the property.

Who is responsible for what?

Each week the HOA office receives many calls wanting to know if the HOA is responsible for a specific area. Here is a brief rundown of some of the more common questions.

Amenity and Common Areas: These areas are owned and maintained by the Legacy Park HOA. The dues paid by each homeowner contribute to the upkeep of these areas: The main Legacy Park entrance, the area along Legacy Park Boulevard, Lake Legacy, the area along Legacy Park Circle, the neighborhood entrances and monuments, Town Green, neighborhood playgrounds, Town Club, Pools, Pump Houses, Amphitheater, Tennis Courts, Basketball Court, Baseball field, Walking Trails, Bridges, Picnic Grove and the Bandstand. To report a problem in one of these areas contact the HOA office.

Streets & Sidewalks: All of the streets within Legacy Park are owned and maintained by the City of Kennesaw. The KPD has the right to ticket and/or tow any car illegally parked on the street or sidewalk. The non-emergency number for the KPD is 770-422-2505.

Streetlights: The ornamental streetlights and the lights at the common areas are maintained by the HOA. To report an outage, contact the HOA (if the pole is numbered, please provide this information). The "cobra head" streetlights are owned and maintained by Georgia Power or Cobb EMC depending on who provides the power in the area. To report a light problem, contact GA Power at 888-655-5888 or Cobb EMC at 770-249-2100 or visit their websites and report an outdoor lighting issue.

Trees along neighborhood streets: The homeowner is the owner of the trees that are planted in the neighborhoods between the street and the sidewalk. It is the responsibility of the individual homeowner to prune these trees on a regular basis. The city recommends that you remove any branches growing at a height lower than 6 feet.

Power Lines: Georgia Power owns the high voltage power lines that run through Legacy Park. Legacy Park owns the property and Georgia Power has an easement. Both the HOA and Georgia Power take care of cutting the grass and maintaining the land that the lines are located on. If there is an issue, contact the HOA Office.

Storm Water Drainage Areas: These areas that run between neighborhoods and at the back of homeowner's lots are generally owned by the individual homeowner. Each homeowner should refer to the plat of their property for further clarification. However, if a major drainage problem exists with the drain itself the homeowner should contact the HOA office and we can direct you to the proper authorities to address the issue (Cobb County Water or the City of Kennesaw).
